COMP STATED THAT TODAY AT 1630 HRS SHE AND HER HUSBAND WENT TO BED HAVE A NAP AT 1630 HRS. THE COMP STATED THAT JUST BEFORE 1800 HRS, THE PHONE RANG. THE COMP GOT UP TO ANSWER THE PHONE. THE PHONE CALL WAS FOR HER HUSBAND. THE COMP WENT TO THE BEDROOM TO WAKE UP HE HUSBAND. WHEN HE DID NOT RESPOND TO HER CALLS, SHE TURNED ON THE LIGHT. SHE STATED THAT HER HUSBAND WAS PURPLE. SHE STATED THAT SHE ATTEMPTED CPR AND CALLED 911.

UPON MY ARRIVAL I OBSERVED THE COMP'S HUSBAND ON THE BEDROOM FLOOR. THE PARAMEDICS STATED THAT THE COMP'S HUSBAND WAS DEAD, DESPITE THERE EFFORTS.

I CONTACTED SGT. BERGER, AND ADVISED HIM THAT THE COMP'S HUSBAND HAD NOT BEEN ILL, HE DID NOT HAVE A LOCAL DOCTOR, NOR WAS SUFFERING FROM A LONG TERM ILLNESS.

SGT. BERGER ADVISED CIB, AND FORENSICS DET D. SCOTT RESPONDED, AS WELL AS SGT SULLIVAN ARRIVED PHOTOGRAPH THE SCENE.

THE MEDICAL EXAMINERS OFFICE WAS CALLED, AND THE TRANSPORT UNIT ARRIVED TO REMOVE THE VICTIM.

IT APPEARED TO BE A NATURAL DEATH, BUT THE VICTIM HAD NO LOCAL DOCTOR. THE BODY WAS CHECKED, AND NOTHING SUSPICIOUS WAS SEEN. THE MEDICATION BOTH OLD AND NEW BOTTLES WERE SHOWN TO FORENSICS, AND TAKEN BY THE M.E. OFFICE WITH THE BODY. THERE WERE NUMEROUS BOTTLES OF MEDICATION.
